

# DOTEC-AUDIO DeeTrimCast

## User's Guide

### About DeeTrimCast

Thank you for choosing DOTECAUDIO DeeTrimCast.

DeeTrimCast is a simple plugin which controls the volume from -12dB to +3dB. It can keep the output level constant from any input level.

### Installation on Windows OS

Unzip the downloaded file and execute the included "Setup.exe".  
The plug-in files are installed in the following folders.

#### VST2

64-bit: *C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST2*

#### VST3

64-bit: *C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3*

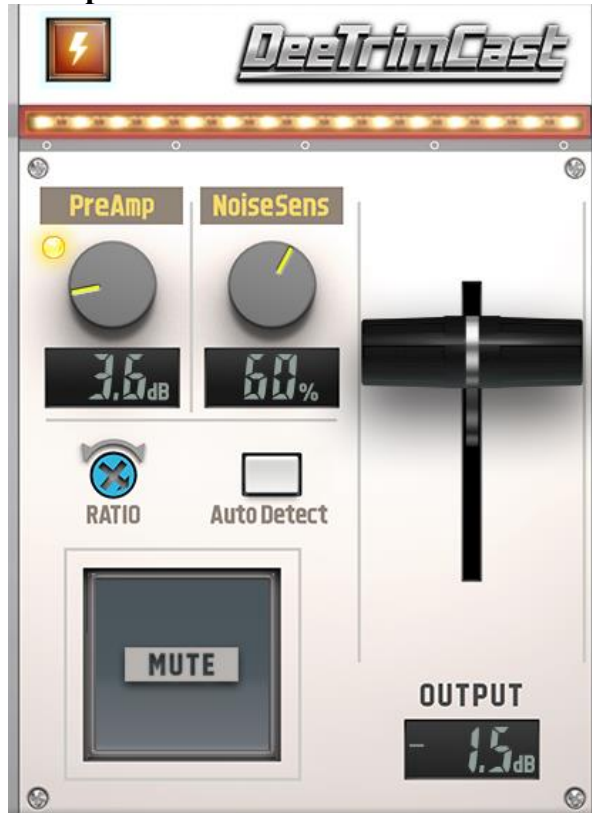
#### AAX

*C:\Program Files\Common Files\Avid\Audio\Plug-Ins*

### Installation on MacOS

1. Those plug-ins are provided as a .vst (VST) and .component (AU) files and .aaxplugin (AAX) files.
2. To install the plug-ins, open "**install.pkg**" and follow the installer instructions.
3. If your music software is already running, you'll probably need to quit and restart before the plugin is recognized.

## Panel Description



**Enable/Disable Switch** (Lightning Switch)  
Enables/Disables DeeTrimCast.

### Main Indicator

It glows red when audio is being output.

### PreAmp

Amplifies the input level. (dB)

### NoiseSens

Adjusts the noise level during silence.

### RATIO

Adjusts the strength of the automatic volume control.

### Auto Detect

Press to adjust NoiseSens automatically.

### MUTE

Mutes the sound.

### Main Fader

Adjusts the target output level. (dB)

### How to adjust:

1. Turn up the microphone input of the audio interface until the yellow light of the **PreAmp** glows when you speak into the microphone. If it is not adjustable, turn it up on the **PreAmp**.
2. Turn up **NoiseSens** until the main indicator does not light up when you do not speak into the microphone. Or press AutoDetect.

## How to Register

The DOTEK-AUDIO product becomes the "**product version**" by registering the serial key and e-mail address in the "**demo version**".

This section describes how to register the serial key you purchased.

### Step 1



You can register serial key by clicking registration button.
